YES vote – District 1 will continue to have a cutting event in conjunction with every CHSRA D1 rodeo. Each cutting will be 2 go's each for boys and girls. Points will be awarded accordingly and **will** count towards the district's year end all-around awards. The top 5 boys and top 5 girls will be invited to the CHSRA State Finals. At the State Finals points in cutting will count towards the all-around cowboy and cowgirl.

NO vote – Cutting will be an optional event and **will not** count towards the district all-around awards. The district will host a minimum of 3 cuttings per season. The district may also choose to attend cutting events with other districts that have an open invitation or sanctioned cutting events that use the HS rodeo scoring system. The district must declare with the state at the beginning of the rodeo season how many cutting events we will have count towards the year end points and awards. The district has the option of holding as many cutting events as we choose and award points only towards the contestant qualifying for the state finals and year end awards. The top 5 girls and top 5 boys will be invited to the state finals based on the number of cutting events the district chooses to count. The district will still give awards to the top 5 girls and top 5 boys in cutting at the end of the year. At the state finals points in cutting will count towards the state all-around cowboy and cowgirl.
